- Expand and verify Shortened URLs before clicking.
- Download free bot removal tools from Cyber Swachhta Kendra <https://www.csk.gov.in/security-tools.html>.
- Log out after using shared or public devices.

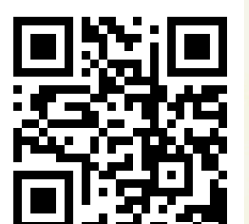
