



Safety Tips

- Use a long password and strong password by mixing upper case and lower-case letters, numbers, and symbols.
- Do not use your name, birthday, or phone number or easily guessable passwords.
- Use different passwords for different accounts.
- Turn on Multi Factor Authentication whenever possible.
- Never share your password or OTP with anyone.

- Do not trust urgent messages asking for money or OTP.
- Check the sender carefully before clicking any link.
- Do not click on unknown links sent by SMS or email.
- Do not click on Short URLs without expanding and verifying them.
- Never share banking information or sensitive personal information over phone or online.

Safety Tips

- Always lock your phone with PIN, password, or fingerprint.
- Download apps only from official app stores.
- Update your phone regularly when updates are available.
- Check app permissions — do not allow unnecessary access to camera or contacts.
- Remove apps you don't use.
